10/25/19	6000 block of Birch Street, Village of Weston	A 24 year old female reported she was the victim of domestic abuse when her 26 year old boyfriend had a verbal and physical altercation with her. The male strangled the female at her residence on Weston Pines Lane, in the Village of Weston, on 10/22/19 between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. This case is cleared by arrest as the male was located and booked into the Marathon County Jail.
10/21/19	6100 block of Ryan Street, Village of Weston	A 35 year old male victim/complainant reports that a GSG, model 5, .22 caliber, AR style rifle is missing from his residence on Ryan Street in the Village of Weston. The timeframe when it went missing is unknown. This case is closed with no follow up necessary.
