LW 20001620 <i>Drug /narcotic Violations - Possess /deliver /manufacture</i>	On 07/11/2020 a 35 year old male with a revoked driving status was observed driving and fled on foot after he was contacted by an officer. Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia were located in the vehicle in which he fled from. Charges were referred to the district attorney's office.	
LW 20001626 <i>Disorderly Conduct</i>	On 07/11/2020 at approximately 22:51 hours, an unknown female got into a verbal altercation with an employee at a store in the 5600 block of Business Highway 51 in the Village of Weston. I attempted contact with the female but was unsuccessful. This case is closed.	
LW 20001625 <i>Probation Violation - 90z</i>	A traffic stop was conducted where a passenger female was found to be in violation of probation conditions. Information was given to probation and parole.
