LW 20002478 <i>Drug /narcotic Violations - Possess /deliver /manufacture</i>	A person was found in possession of methamphetamine and paraphernalia in the 2000 block of Jelinek Avenue.	
LW 20002479 <i>Crash Tpd</i>	On 10/16/2020 a two vehicle property damage only crash occurred near the 2600 block of Schofield Avenue in the Village of Weston.	
LW 20002480 <i>Assault - Simple</i>	On 10/16/2020, a 26 year old female reported she was punched while she was at work in the Village of Weston.

The male then resisted officers during the arrest. The male was arrested and placed on a probation hold for disorderly conduct, resisting arrest, probation violations, and felony bail jumping. Due to no leads or suspects, this case is closed with no follow up needed.
