Super Late Model Notes: Justin Mondeik became just the third late model driver in State Park Speedway history to win three consecutive championships when he clinched the title on Season Championship Night Thursday. Mondeik finished the season with six feature wins, one shy of his total of seven a year ago, and joins Dick Trickle (1970-72, 1981-83) and Wayne Breitenfeldt (1994-2000) as the only drivers to win three straight late model titles at SPS... The top three in the point standings were the same as last year, with Jason Weinkauff second and Travis Volm third. Volm finished with three feature wins this year, though, after going winless a year ago, while Weinkauff went without a win after picking up one last season. Weinkauff did finish in the top 3 in all ten features, including seven runner-up finishes... In all, the top 10 in the points last year and this year included nine of the same names, with only Jerry Brickner new to the top 10 this year while Brock Heinrich was 13th this year after finishing seventh a year ago... Twenty-seven different drivers competed in the class this year, one more than a year ago,

Pure Stock Notes: Mitch Stankowski clinched his second straight pure stocks championship, but needed to borrow the car of Brett Breitenfeldt to do so after the transmission broke on his car in practice laps Thursday... Brian Plisch won his first career feature at State Park to become the sixth different feature winner this year... Jevin Guralski finished as the class's Rookie of the Year and led the pure stocks with five heat wins, second-most at the track this year behind only Ashley Schoone's six heat wins in the mini stocks... The 21 cars to compete in the class this year is four more than a year ago, including 11 drivers appearing this year who did not race at SPS in 2021.

Mini Stock Notes: A full season, 12 nights of racing, and in the end Garret Strachota and Eric Breitenfeldt finished in a dead heat tie in the point standings. The tiebreaker ended up being feature wins, with Strachota posting four and Breitenfeldt officially three for tiebreaking purposes. He also was the top finisher in a fourth feature after the winner was disqualified, but first-place points are not awarded so that does not count as an official feature win... Ashley Schoone led the class and the track with six heat wins this year... Tyler Muller finished as the class Rookie of the Year, making the two-hour drive weekly to SPS from Sun Prairie outside of Madison.

Mini Mod Notes: Veteran “Snappy” Joe Kuehn won his first-ever State Park Speedway championship. Kuehn finished third a year ago but was the most consistent driver in the class as the only driver to finish in the top 10 in all ten feature races this season... Josh Willhite and the late George Seliger led the class with three feature wins each... Zach Degner drove Seliger’s former car in the season finale, won his heat race and finished second in the feature... Hunter Landwehr earned Rookie of the Year honors in the class and led the mini mods with four heat wins... Eighteen drivers earned points in the class this year, the same number as a year ago. Eleven of the 18 drivers picked up a race win, and a 12th (Carson Strese) earned fast time honors.

Bandolero Notes: Alex Hartwig closed out his time in the Bandoleros with his third SPS track championship in four years, and did so in style with a clean sweep setting fast time, winning his heat and then the feature last week... Hartwig finished the season winning four of the Bandos’ six features, with Penn Sauter and Cohen Henze also winning one feature each... Oliver Weinkauff came on strong late in the season, picking up his first-ever heat win Aug. 11 and finishing fourth in each of the last two features of the season... Cole Kurth also had his best-ever feature run last week, as the son of longtime late model racer Kirby Kurth finished fifth last week and after starting in the back of the pack after not arriving at the track until after qualifying... Laci Stargardt is another finishing out her time in Bandoleros before “aging out” of the cars for kids age 8-14, and she finished at State Park with a heat win last week as well as a sixth-place feature finish. Last year’s Rookie of the Year in the class also finished fifth in the point standings this year... With Stargardt and Ayden Brockhouse both picking up their first wins of the season last week, a total of 12 drivers won at least one race in the class this year... The 26 drivers to race in the Bandoleros class this year also marks a new season high for the class, which debuted at State Park Speedway in 2013.

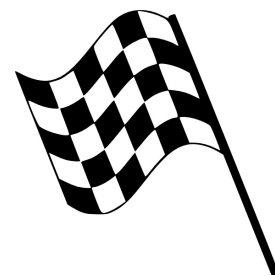
