**Super Late Model Notes:** Justin Mondeik became just the third late model driver in State Park Speedway history to win three consecutive championships when he clinched the title on Season Championship Night. Mondeik finished the season with six feature wins, one shy of his total of seven in 2021, and joins Dick Trickle (1970-72, 1981-83) and Wayne Breitenfeldt (1994-2000) as the only drivers to win three straight late model titles at SPS... The top three in the point standings were the same as the year before, with Jason Weinkauf second and Travis Volm third. Volm finished with three feature wins this year, after going winless a year earlier, while Weinkauf went without a win after picking up one in 2021. Weinkauf did finish in the top 3 in all ten features, including seven runner-up finishes... In all, the top 10 in the points in 2021 and 2022 included nine of the same names, with only Jerry Brickner new to the top 10 while Brock Heinrich was 13th after finishing seventh in 2021... Twenty-seven different drivers competed in the class, one more than a year earlier,

**Pure Stock Notes:** Mitch Stankowski won his second straight pure stocks championship in 2022 driving the 19th Hole car which will be raced by Brett Breitenfeldt this year... Brian Plisch won his first career feature at State Park in the season finale to become the sixth different feature winner in the class in 2022... Jevin Guralski finished as the class's Rookie of the Year and led the pure stocks with five heat wins, second-most at the track for the season behind only Ashley Schoone's six heat wins in the mini stocks... The 21 cars to compete in the class was four more than a year earlier, including 11 drivers appearing in 2022 who did not race at SPS in 2021.

**Mini Stock Notes:** After a full season of 12 nights of racing, in the end Garret Strachota and Eric Breitenfeldt finished in a dead heat tie in the point standings. The tiebreaker ended up being feature wins, with Strachota posting four and Breitenfeldt officially three for tiebreaking purposes. He also was the top finisher in a fourth feature after the winner was disqualified, but first-place points are not awarded so that did not count as an official feature win for tiebreaking purposes... Ashley Schoone led the class and the track with six heat wins in 2022... Tyler Muller finished as the class Rookie of the Year, making the two-hour drive weekly to SPS from Sun Prairie outside of Madison... Zach Budleski came in a career-best third in points, while Joey Blaschka also posted a career-best seventh-place points finish.

**Mini Mod Notes:** Veteran "Snappy" Joe Kuehn won his first-ever State Park Speedway championship in 2022. Kuehn was the most consistent driver in the class as the only driver to finish in the top 10 in all ten feature races last year... Josh Willhite and the late George Seliger led the class with three feature wins each... Zach Degner drove Seliger's former car in the season finale, won his heat race and finished second in the feature. He also drove the car in September in the George Seliger Memorial and won the feature... Hunter Landwehr earned Rookie of the Year honors in the class and led the mini mods with four heat wins... Eighteen drivers earned points in the class, the same number as a year ago. Eleven of the 18 drivers picked up a race win, and a 12th (Carson Strese) earned fast time honors.

**Midwest Trucks Notes:** The Midwest Trucks are racing in the State Park Speedway season opener for the third straight year and for the 15th time since their first visit 12 years ago... Bryce Miller has won the last two trucks features at SPS, including last year's 50-lapper when he took the lead from Koby Hubred on lap 8 and led the final 43 laps. James Lynch came in second with Hubred third, Kevin Knuese fourth and James Swan fifth... Miller and Swan are the only two-time truck series winners at SPS, and also are the only two past winners at the track expected to compete Saturday... Thirty-one trucks were on hand for the series' first race of the season May 7 at Madison International Speedway, where Lynch won the Joe Shear Classic 36, leading all 36 laps for his second career Midwest Truck Series victory.

**One year ago:** The season opened on a Saturday for the second straight year and Justin Mondeik began his quest for a third straight super late model championship by winning the 60-lap feature, taking the point from Jason Weinkauf on lap 15 and leading the rest of the way. Weinkauf finished second in the 14-car field followed by Mark Mackesy, Rayce Haase and Jeremy Lepak.

Columbus native Bryce Miller won the Midwest Trucks feature at SPS for the second straight year, while other feature winners included rookie Jevin Guralski in the pure stocks as he held off Brian Schramm and Mitch Stankowski for the win. Josh Willhite won the feature in the mini mods class and Garret Strachota bested Eric Breitenfeldt and Joey Blaschka in mini stocks.
