Super Late Model Notes: The season opener on May 20th brought a historically fast night in the super late models in part due to repaving both turns 1 and 2 as well as 3 and 4, plus an intriguing feature race that included four leaders, six lead changes and several good side-by-side battles. Brock Heinrich rose above all on the night, first setting a track record with a quick lap in qualifying of 13.326 seconds, and then by winning the 60-lap feature for his third-ever feature win in the class at State Park... Jason Weinkauff came in second in the feature, dueling with Heinrich on a final restart with seven laps left and even leading a lap before Heinrich regained the lead. Weinkauff also was runner-up in seven of 10 super late features at SPS last year... Jeremy Lepak also had a strong run, challenging Heinrich in the latter stages of the feature and finishing third... Three-time defending champion Justin Mondeik was fourth in the feature while SLM rookie Jevin Guralski came in fifth in his first race in the class. Guralski is a former Bandoleros champion at the track... Dillon Hammond is returning to racing this year after a year off. The former ARCA Midwest Series regular is running the No. 93 Satorius Racing car, and he finished seventh in the feature... Carter Christenson made his first-ever appearance at SPS in the opener, and along with Rayce Haase gave the division to No. 02 cars in the class for one night. Like Haase, Christenson is a third-generation driver, coming from the La Crosse area, and he finished ninth of 14 cars in the feature.

Pure Stock Notes: The first pure stocks feature of the season was won by Dave Cabelka, driving a car that has plenty of experience running up front at State Park. The car was formerly raced by Brian (Butchie) Schramm before Cabelka purchased it after Schramm retired from racing after last season... Another change in the class is in the 19th Hole car, as Brett Breitenfeldt will wheel the car driven by Mitch Stankowski to back-to-back championships in 2021 and 2022. Breitenfeldt also is racing his own No. 14 pure stock at Golden Sands Speedway on Friday nights... New to the class this year is Steve Schilling, who drove the No. 15 car on opening night. Schilling also was the winner of a \$100 bonus for finishing fifth in the feature on opening night May 20. Schramm Racing will pay a \$100 bonus every feature this year in the pure stock class, to a random finishing position selected before the feature every race this season.

Mini Mod Notes: Opening night brought a feature win in the mini mods for a driver who hasn't visited State Park Speedway in some time. Tim Anderson won the class's main in what he said was his first race at the track since being involved in a wreck nine years ago... New-comers to the mini mods this year include Branden Sischo and Brad Abt, both moving up from racing in mini stocks the last couple years. Sischo led some laps and finished a strong second in the feature, while Abt exited early and finished 10th... Defending champion Snappy Joe Kuehn set fast time and finished third in the feature... First-time SPS visitors Mike Meharg and Kamren Hill both won heat races, and Hill came back to take sixth in the feature.

Mini Stock Notes: Eric Breitenfeldt has had as much success as almost any driver at State Park over the past three seasons, and he showed no signs of letting up in 2023 with a feature win on opening night. Including non-points nights and a win following a disqualification, the win was his 14th feature win at SPS since 2020... Sam Sheahen had a strong start to the season in the 715 car. Sheahen was one of the fastest qualifiers of the night and then finished second to Breitenfeldt in the feature in his first weekly points race at State Park. Sheahen also raced in the George Seliger Memorial last September... Zach Budleski finished third in the feature for his best-ever feature finish... Dawson Knutson is another who made his first-ever appearance in a weekly points race at SPS and had an excellent showing. Knutson finished fifth in the feature, driving a former State Park feature-winning car previously raced by Shawn Kemnetz.

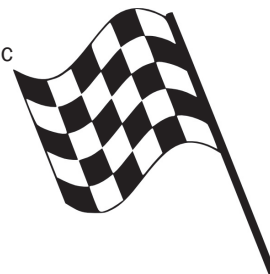

SCHEDULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

This week in State Park Speedway history

June 9, 1977: A borrowed car was no problem for Dick Trickle as he won the 30-lap feature event, with Tom Reffner second, Marv Marzofka third and Larry Detjens fourth. Trickle drove the No. 2 car of Jim Bohmsach for the night. Ron Beyer of Stevens Point won the semi-feature, while fast time went to Tom Steuding of Altoona. Reffner won the trophy dash and heat winners were Joe Krzykowski, Bob Mackesy and Detjens.

June 7, 1984: Rain shortened the program on Golden Guernsey June Dairy Night, with the night's program called by rain during the late model semi-feature. Bob Mackesy won the late model trophy dash, Joe Krzykowski, Royce Rossier and Wayne Lodholz won heat races and Brian Shimkus was recognized as the semi-feature winner. Hobby stock winners included Larry Lepak in the trophy dash and Steve Paoli, Ron Will and Mitch Morgan in heat races. A cow milking contest also saw Keith Witt edge Greg Holzhausen, outmilking his opponent three glasses to two.

One year ago: Justin Mondeik won his second feature of the season, getting by Parker Retzlaff with 11 laps left on the way to winning the 50-lap super late model feature. Legends cars returned to State Park Speedway for the first time in 20 years and Tristan Swanson won the feature event. Other victors included Mitch Stankowski in the pure stocks, Snappy Joe Kuehn in the mini mods, Garret Strachota in the mini stocks and Alex Hartwig in the Bandoleros.
